**REPORTS:** 

<u>Fire Dept:</u> Chief Ryan Lewis told the Council the department responded to 7 fire call and 4 medical assists. The fire prevention week had a good turnout of kids with 21 taking part in the program. 10 sets of new bunker gear have been ordered they have one set yet to order. Bill Sherwood will bring the invoice to the town to be paid thru wind impact funds. Eagle Plumbing has been working on the heaters at the fire department and Prairie Dog Electric has been putting in new wiring. The department is switching there bay lighting to LED fixtures. Without a motion the Council told Sherwood to go ahead and order the new lights.

<u>SCWEMS:</u> The monthly meeting is at the Elk Mountain Fire Hall tonight.

<u>Water Dept.</u>: Superintendent Eastman was unable to attend the meeting but told the Clerk that things are good at the water treatment plant.

Zoning: No report.

<u>Public Works:</u> Director Neuman left a report with the Mayor that included an incident with one of the town dumpsters at the Conoco Station. A motorist hit the dumpster running it thru the wall at the station. He needed to know how much it was valued at so the owners could put in an insurance claim. Bill Sherwood and Bob O'Connor helped Neuman tweak the door on the trash truck until it can be repaired. Neuman and Page will hang the new Christmas decorations when they are both available. The lagoon sensors are ordered but the company said not to expect them to be shipped until after the 26<sup>th</sup> of November because they will need calibrated. Neuman leveled the sewer lagoon propane tank and placed the town hall tank on a concrete pad.

<u>HCJPB</u>: Ken Campbell reported that the Board purchased a dump truck from Carbon County Road and Bridge. They are looking at health insurance policies for employees. Medicine Bow and Elk Mountain representatives have been tasked with pricing a new garbage truck. The Board paid bills in the amount of \$5,929.28.

<u>Museum Board</u>: Cm. Kenneda told the Council that the Board had accepted the resignation of Kellsie Domnitz as Museum Director.
