CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Irene called the meeting to order at 6:30PM. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVE MINUTES: Cm. Kennedy made a motion to approve the October 12, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes; Cm. Mustard seconded the motion; Council Poll; Cm. Hobbs Aye, Mayor Irene Aye, Cm. Jones Absent, Cm. Kennedy Aye, Cm. Mustard Aye, motion carries.

CITIZEN ADDRESSING THE COUNCIL: Kassey Westring with Northfork Engineering gave an update on the 2019 Street Improvement Project. She presented the engineers estimate of probably project cost at \$415,741.00. She would place the invitation to bid in the Rawlins Daily Times on Dec. 9th and 16th with a bid opening on Dec. 23rd. **Cm. Hobbs made a motion to advertise the invitation to bid;** Cm. Kennedy seconded motion; Cm. Hobbs Aye, Mayor Irene Aye, Cm. Jones Absent, Cm. Kennedy Aye, Cm. Mustard Aye, motion carries.

REPORTS:

Fire Dept: Assistant Fire Chief Meyer told the Council everything is up and running for equipment. They are getting bids to retrofit the M1 unit. The Chili Cookoff is Dec. 12th and there are raffle tickets on sale for the 911 Quilt made and donated by Kathy Williams. In Sept., the department had 16 calls & 4 cancelations: 10-wildland fires, 2 vehicle fires, 1 power line, 2 medical, 1 crash. Oct. had 12 calls & 5 cancelations: 2 rollovers, 3 semi blow overs, 1 controlled burn, 3 medicals, Smoke on the 316 fire, 1 vehicle fire.

SCWEMS: Mayor Irene attended the SCWEMS meeting in Saratoga last month. An assessment the service had preformed a few years back told the service that they could not be sustainable running the operation the way they were. The service revisited their recommendation to downsize their ambulance barns and ambulances and run a North and South unit. He asked the Councils opinion on making a change like this.

Public Works: Superintendent Page reported his sanitary survey was done Oct. 15th with the results 9-12 months out. He is working with the EPA on updating our site plans. Work continues on the dumpsters; the Senior Center is completed, and they are moving things back in. Page asked the Council opinion on getting our own dumpster from AAA Recycling to dispose of metal. He will look into the cost. After visiting with Craig McOmie, WDEQ he would be able to place video cameras around the trash trailer and

metal bin instead of having to fence and hire someone to man the gate. Page is researching other towns ordinance pertaining to tap fee and material costs on water and sewer hookups. He presented the Council with packets on various man lifts. **Cm. Mustard made a motion to purchase a skid steer lift;** Cm. Hobbs seconded the motion; Council Poll; Cm. Hobbs Aye, Mayor Irene Aye, Cm. Jones Absent, Cm. Kennedy Aye, Cm. Mustard Aye, motion carries. The COVID wastewater sampling is showing positive results. Page asked the Council if it was still okay to purchase the bumper crane for the pickup they had approved in the spring.

HCJPB: The Nov. meeting was in Elk Mountain, there were not enough Board members present for a quorum. They authorized paying the bills and ratify at their next meeting. They discussed putting out to bid excess equipment and the office trailer. The reclamation of the landfill is complete.

Museum Board: Director Hobbs said the wagon were stored in the Bjork Building for the winter. The Council and Staff signed a thank you card to Margaret Karstoff for her donation to the museum building project. She said the museums website has had 9,500 visits.

CCVC: Crane sent out the minutes from the CCVC meetings.

CCCOG: Next meeting is in Rawlins

LEPC: Bob Meyer reported Lenny Lehman, Carbon County Emergency Management Coordinator will be working on THIRA this winter and have a presentation for the commissioners. Carbon County Coordination Center, a communications plan, is being worked on. There are available moneys and a building. It can house 9 workstations and phone members. The staffing will be volunteer. The TYPE 3 Team is on hold but will continue to train.
